'End Table'

Designed in 1923, executed in ca. 1958-1964.

Painted beech and plywood, 60 x 50 x 50 cm.

Manufactured by Rietveld's regular cabinetmaker Gerard van de Groenekan, the Netherlands.
Stamped at the underside of the base: H.G.M./G.A. v.d. GROENEKAN/DE BILT NEDERLAND.

The 'end table' also called 'divan table' was designed by Rietveld in 1923. It served as an occasional table next to a divan-bench in the famous Rietveld/Schröder house in the city of Utrecht, the Netherlands.

The table here on offer has a spectacular provenance since it's origin is this famous house. It belonged to Truus Schröder the owner and inhabitant of the Rietveld/Schröder house and was made during the period she and Rietveld lived there together from 1958 till his death in 1964.
